Ms. Frey is the Director, Overseas Financial Operations in the Resource Management Directorate headquartered at Kapaun AS, with direct reporting to the Chief Financial Officer at Ft. Lee Virginia. She is responsible for financial and manpower oversight for 33 commissaries, 2 central distribution centers, 1 central meat processing plant, and 4 NEXMARTS in **Europe**, and 25 commissaries and 7 central distribution centers in the **Pacific** spreading over 8 time zones. Ms. Frey is accountable for a resale activity of \$778M, DWCF of \$210M, Surcharge of \$16M and construction of \$85M. Secondary DeCA provides direct customers support to 43 embassies and various other DOD and Non-DOD authorized customers.

Ms. Frey began her Defense Commissary Agency career in 1982. She held various positions within Resource Management and special assignments, i.e., from 1990 to 1991, Ms. Frey held the position as Financial Transition Team Lead for Europe from the military services into the Defense Commissary Agency; and in 2010 working as a Project Lead at DeCA Headquarters at Ft. Lee, Virginia, being responsible for two out of five major processes within the Defense Agencies Initiative (DAI) working closely with the Business Transformation Agency (BTA) and Acquisition, Technology and Logistics (AT&L) Risk Management. In 2021 to present she is leading the financial business transformation for all overseas DeCA facilities and supported locations.

Ms. Frey is the subject matter expert for the Enterprise Business Solution (EBS) financial implementation for the overseas environment including locations in Europe and the Pacific.

Ms. Frey received various awards to include the Superior Meritorious Civilian Service Award, the Rheinland-Pfalz American Society Military Comptroller Award, the National under Major Command Comptroller Award for the American Society of Military Comptroller, the American Logistics Association/DeCA Joel McCarty Award; DeCA EEO Award; the Michael W. Blackwell Leadership Award for exceptional leadership, courage, integrity and in November 2019 the Top Women in Grocery National Award by the Progressive Grocer.
